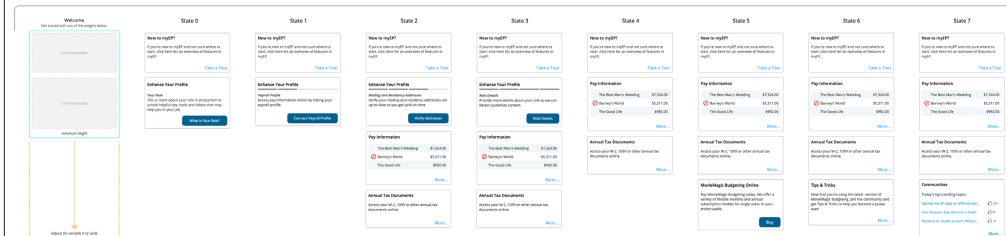
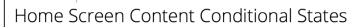

E — User Flow: Controlling a device + UI control states / micro-interaction details

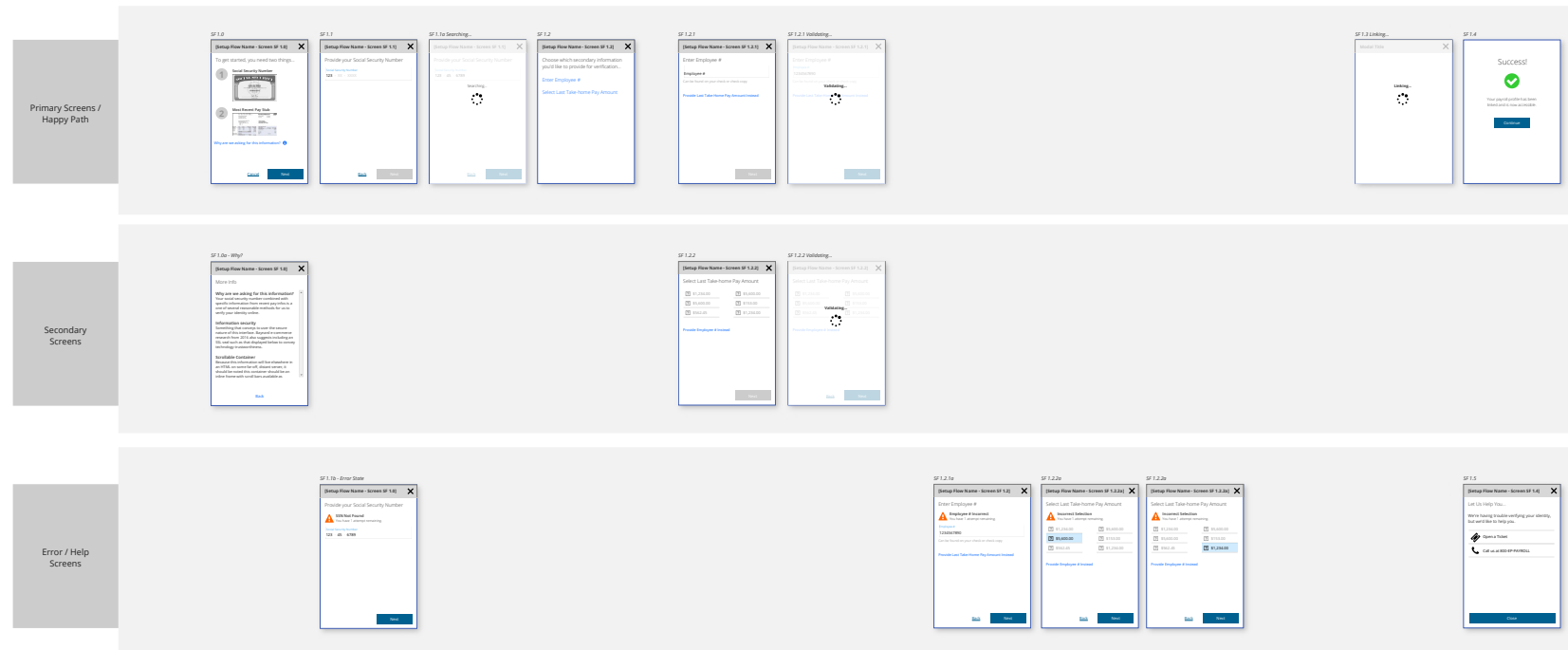
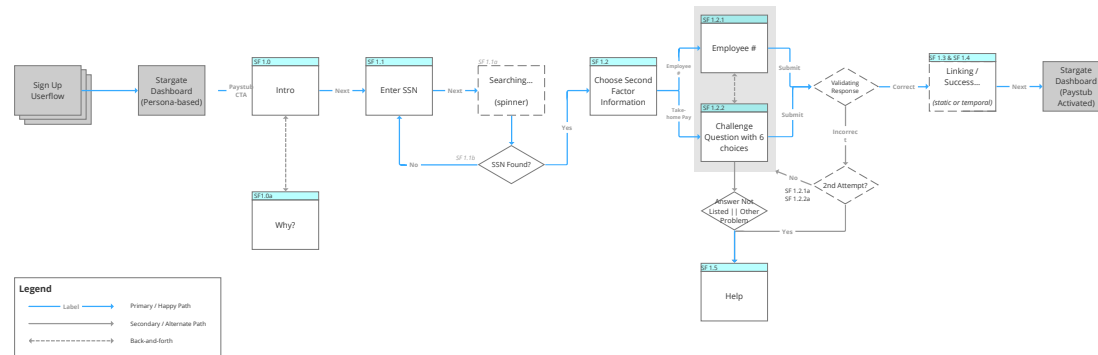

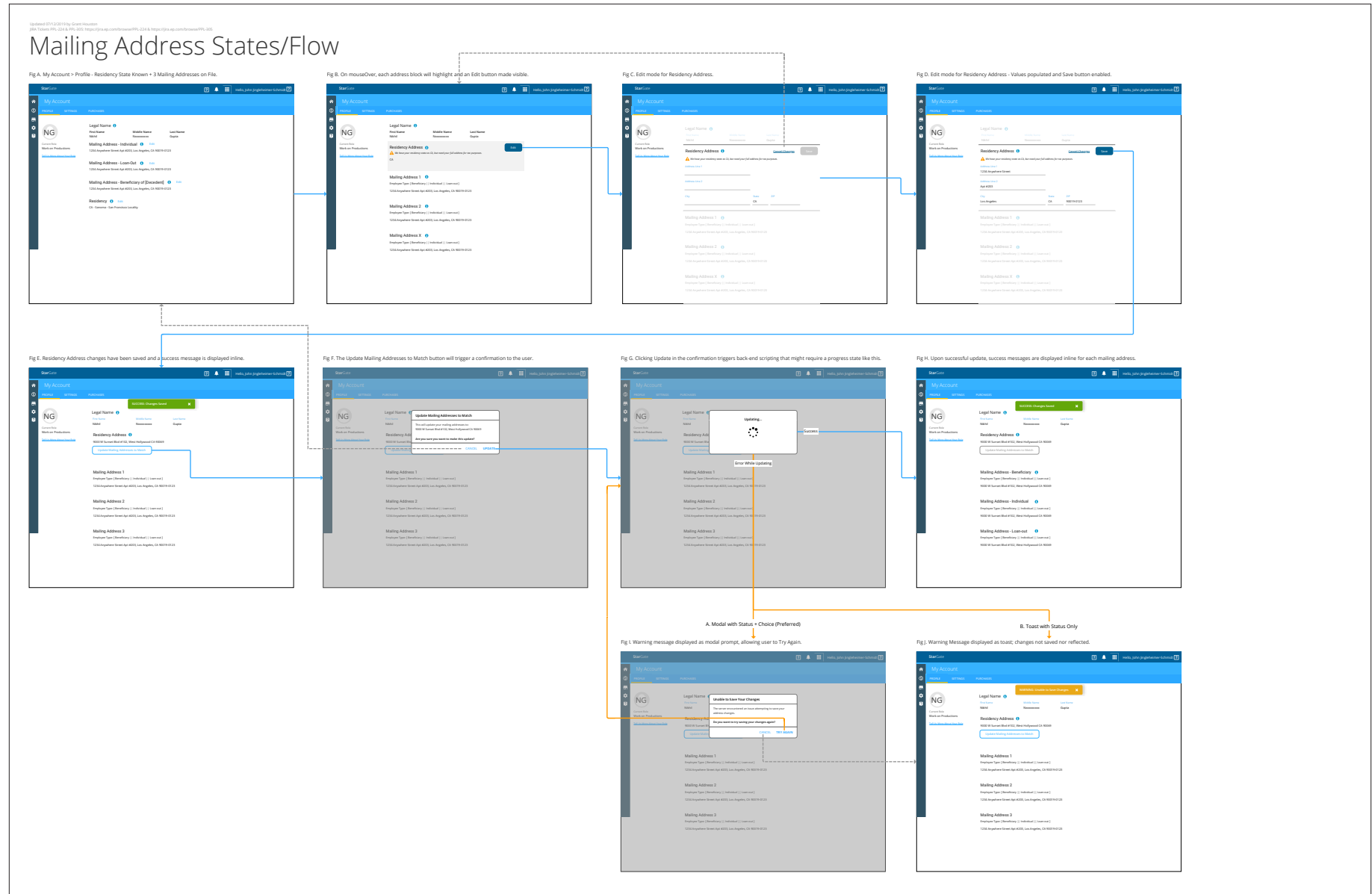

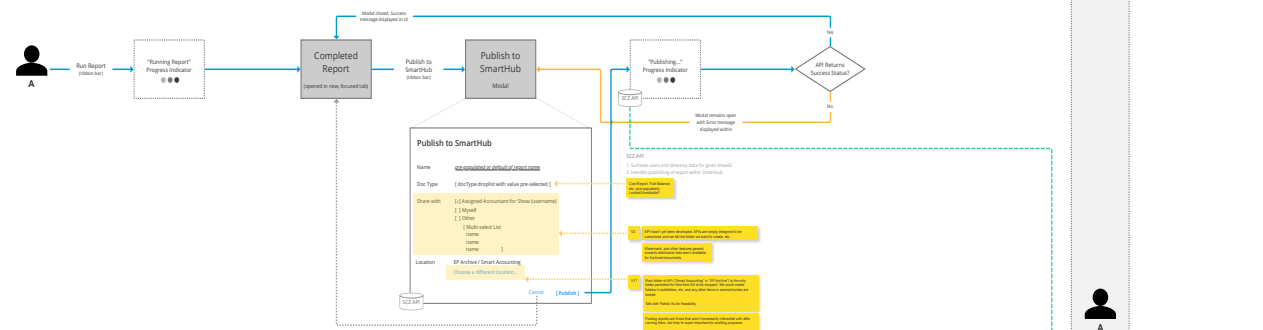
